Sustainability Project: Completed the plant data for the LCA (information sent to Stan Lipkowski with AMD). Agreement with SCS Global Services signed who will be conducting the review and delivering the industry wide EPD for CSPI Members.

OPSD Height of Cover Tables: Held two Go-To-Meetings to review CSPI's response to the Ontario Provincial Standard Committee's project on standardizing tables. Response sent out on the 31<sup>st</sup>.

Conferences: Submitted abstracts to Tri Party (Red Deer), Canadian Society for Civil Engineers (Fredericton) and Short and Medium Span Bridges (Quebec City) for 2018 Conferences.
